NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DETROIT, TEXAS WILL HOLD A REGULAR MEETING AT THE ABOVE-NAMED DATE, TIME, AND LOCATION

All agenda items are subject to action.

1. CALL TO ORDER.
2. Public Comment: Members of the public may speak on an **agenda item** during the public comment section of the meeting or at the time the agenda item is called for discussion by the presiding officer. Speakers are given three (3) minutes to address the council once they are announced by the presiding officer. Members of the public wishing to address the Council on **non-agenda items** may do so pursuant to the same time constraints as agenda items. Consistent with the Texas Open Meetings Act, the Council members cannot discuss non-agenda items. Speaking times are specific to each speaker and cannot be accumulated, saved or transferred to another speaker.
All speakers are expected to maintain a proper decorum when presenting and while in Council chambers. Threats, personal insults, vulgar or profane language is out of order and may result in removal from the meeting. **All requests for comment must be in writing and turned into the City Secretary or Presiding Officer at least 5 minutes prior to the start of the meeting.**
3. New Business – Discuss and Take Action on:
 - a. Approval of Ordinance No. 2026.3.27a ratifying an Order of Election for the May 2, 2026 General Election and ratifying the calling of the election for the purpose of electing three (3) members to the Detroit City Council for two-year terms each at the May 2, 2026, General Election.
 - b. Adopting Ordinance No. 2026.3.27b, an Ordinance of the City of Detroit, Texas, (City”), repealing conflicting ordinances and orders, including Ordinance No. 2026.3.27a and **canceling** the May 2, 2026 General Election, ordered for the purpose of electing three members to the City Council, each for a term of two (2) years; declaring each unopposed candidate elected to office in accordance with State Law; Providing a Cumulative Repealer Clause; Providing a Severability Clause; Providing for Engrossment and Enrollment; and Effective Date.
4. Reschedule May 4th regular meeting (attorney available on May 7th)
5. EXECUTIVE SESSION

Consultation with Attorney § 551.071 to conduct a private consultation with its attorney related to pending or contemplated litigation, a settlement offer, and/or a matter in which there exists a duty of the City Attorney to the governmental body under the Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas that conflicts with Texas Government Code Chapter 551:

- a. May 2, 2026 General Election

Following the closed Executive Session, the Council will reconvene in open and public session and take any such action as may be desirable or necessary as a result of the closed deliberations.

7. Adjourn.
