

MINUTES
DETROIT CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING
June 1, 2026

The Detroit City Council met in regular session on Monday, June 1, 2026, at 7:07 P.M. Mayor Kenneth Snodgrass called the meeting to order. Council members in attendance were Faye Marshall and Tonya Clanton, Terrie Shelby, and Donnie Mitchell in attendance.

No public comment

New business discussed and moved upon:

- a. Account balances reviewed and discussed
- b. July meeting was not moved from scheduled date of July 6 (first Monday)
- c. Advisement of new TABC Off Premise retail sales from Dollar General

Old Business – Discuss and Take Action on:

- a. Christian Street R.O.W. reviewed and discussed. Motion was made by Terrie Shelby and seconded by the Faye Marshall to reach out to Ryan Hammett Surveying to review 2 surveys provided by L. Clanton and 1 survey provided by A. Wilhite along with any relevant recorded documents to determine the exact length and location of the undeveloped R.O.W. – so that all adjoining land owners can be notified and the properties treated equally. Motion carried 3-0 with T. Clanton abstaining
- b. Streets/Alleys – work has been on Bennet and Brunswick. Crittenden needs blade work due to recent rains – will reach out to RRC Commissioner David Hutson
- c. Copies of Red River County Water Supply and City of Paris employee handbooks were distributed to council members. They were asked to take home, review and highlight sections that they would like to see implemented in a new City of Detroit handbook. Will review at next meeting.

Motion was made by Tonya Clanton and seconded by Terrie Shelby to approve the bills:

- a. C-RAE Materials, LLC - \$1,648.34 – 15.880 tons Type D cold mix (DISD split the cost)
- b. Messer & Fort Municipal Law - \$641.00 – legal fees re: election consultation, ordinances, etc
- c. Plus 1 Services - \$725.00 – annual wastewater flow meter calibration

After review, Motion was made by Tonya Clanton and seconded by Terrie Shelby to approve the minutes with a correction to: 05/12/26 bill approval motions – name spelling

Council did not enter Executive Session per C. Arrasmith's choice to remain in Open session: C. Arrasmith did not attempt to take the Wastewater Class C license exam due to not having an open application with TCEQ. Motion was made by Faye Marshall and seconded by Tonya Clanton to amend the PIP to extend the deadline for the attempt (pass or fail) and the timeline for no new complaints out 3 months – NEW date of 09/01/2026. And to amend the required exam pass date by 3 months – NEW date of 12/01/2026. The 3-month timeline is to allow for a new application to be filed with TCEQ and their processing timeline of 4-6 weeks to approve application before allowing testing. C. Arrasmith is to have the new application submitted to TCEQ before the July meeting.
