

MINUTES
DETROIT CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING
September 7, 2026

The Detroit City Council met in regular session on Monday, September 7, 2026, at 12:18 P.M. Mayor Kenneth Snodgrass called the meeting to order. Council members in attendance were Tonya Clanton, Terrie Shelby, Bobby Miller, Faye Marshall and Donnie Mitchell.

Council member, Faye Marshall spoke during public comment to speak against the FLOCK camera that was recently installed on Hwy 82 West across from the City Park. She asked if the City could act on the issue at the next meeting to insist that the camera be removed from inside the City limits.

New business discussed and moved upon:

- a. Account balances reviewed and discussed
 - b. Motion was made by Tonya Clanton and seconded by Bobby Miller to approve the 2026-2027 Water & Sewer budget. Motion carried 5-0
 - c. Motion was made by Tonya Clanton and seconded by Terrie Shelby to approve the 2026-2027 General Fund budget Motion carried 5-0
- ** Meetings for Proposing the 2026-2027 property tax rate and Adopting the proposed rate have been set for 1PM for September 22 and September 2, 2026.*

Old Business – Discuss and Take Action on:

- a. Streets/Alleys – Multiple areas of street patching. Multiple residential culverts installed per request and terms agreed to with residents. Shredding recently along S. Main.
- b. Work on the City of Detroit employee handbook/policy has not begun
- c. Flooding mitigation continued from last month's discussion. Quote for \$19,500 to remove culvert at Smith Street, add casing to water and sewer lines that run across the creek, and replace culverts at Bennett (cost of culvert separate) was submitted for \$19,500.00 by F. Smith at the 08/03/26 meeting. C. Arrasmith met with Commissioner Hudson to verify culvert sizes and needs as submitted by E. Cox. Hudson provided a company to order culverts from. The quote for culverts from Contech Engineered Solutions for 6 culverts came in at \$13,074.14 as delivered. S. Yoder also picked up information and is interested in submitting a bid for culvert replacement (not casing)

Motion was made by Terrie Shelby and seconded by Bobby Miller to approve the bills:

- a. ULINE - \$863.70 – breakaway poles for street signs along Hwy 82
- b. C-Rae Materials, LLC - \$1,530.91 – cold mix
- c. Lower Colorado River Authority - \$1,050.00 – lead & copper testing
